Report on Mercedes-Benz 380 (W22)

Inspection of Mercedes-Benz 380 on 19th June 2025

Carried out at Manor Park Classics, Ikon House Tudor Rd, Runcorn, WA7 1TA

Information on reason for inspection.

Manor Park Classics had approached the Club to see whether the Club Archive held any information on a vehicle which they were offering for sale. A lot of digital information was supplied to the Club, which will be expanded upon in this report, and after subsequent telephone calls it was decided an inspection would take place

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Procedure at Manor Park Classics

- Initially a visual inspection of the vehicle was carried out. It should be noted that due to the condition of the vehicle not all identification numbers/plates could be verified
 - a. The body number was found in front left door jamb, as shown in image 5 The delivery paperwork, Image 6 confirms this.
 - b. No chassis number could be found.
 It was not possible to inspect the whole chassis.
 From experience the chassis number maybe stamped on the front right chassis leg.
 - c. As indicated in the images one would expect to find an identification plate in the engine bay on the left side of the fire wall Image 8
